Salvado Catholic College is a new coeducational Catholic College in Byford that commenced in 2016. In 2018 we have Kindergarten to Year 4 students, as well as running a 3 Year Old Education Program. The College will continue to grow to reach its ultimate capacity as a K-12 College with the first intake of Year 7 students commencing in 2021.

The College patron, Dom Rosendo Salvado was an inspirational missionary, educator, bishop and pioneer colonist who founded the community of New Norcia. The motto "Peace, Justice, Compassion" directly reflects Salvado's life work.

Our vision for Salvado Catholic College is to create a welcoming Catholic community where all our students will come to grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ and reach their full potential in a supportive and engaging learning environment.

Our Stage One Building Program has delivered a modern and purpose built early years learning centre, junior primary learning spaces, nature play spaces, grassed and hard court play areas, an enclosed assembly area, administration building and car parks. The innovatively designed buildings have a focus on shared, flexible learning spaces that support best practice, 21st century teaching and learning approaches.

In 2018 we will commence the Stage Two Build of the Primary part of the Campus and then in 2019 works will commence on the Secondary part of the Campus.

This is an outstanding opportunity for an inspiring educator to positively influence the lives of students in the Byford area and contribute to the formation of a new Catholic College community.

- Be fully supportive of the objectives and ethos of Catholic education.
- Demonstrate pedagogical skills with a flexible, collaborative and student-centred approach.
- Possess a sound knowledge of the Religious Education guidelines, the Early Years Learning Framework, National Quality Standards and the Western Australian Curriculum.
- Demonstrate the ability to use assessment and continuous monitoring methods and tools to adjust the teaching/learning program and teaching practices to cater for the needs of all students.
- Display excellent classroom management and organisational skills.
- Display excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Demonstrate a high level of expertise in integrating digital technologies to enrich teaching and learning experiences.
- Demonstrate the capability to work collaboratively with other staff to promote student learning and to enhance one's own teaching instruction and the learning culture of the College.
- Demonstrate an ability to lead by taking on roles within the College and being involved in extra-curricular activities.
- Demonstrate the capacity and enthusiasm to build community in a new Catholic College in collaboration with staff, parents, parish and students.

Qualifications Required

- Accreditation to Teach Religious Education
- Relevant 4 Year Tertiary Qualifications
- Early Childhood Qualifications

Applicants must submit a curriculum vitae, addressed to the Principal, including the names and contact numbers of three referees - current employer, Parish Priest and professional colleague.

Applicants must have a current registration as a teacher with the Teacher Registration Board of WA (TRBWA) to be eligible for appointment. Information is available from the TRBWA website.
